address the unique needs specific to deaf-blindness. Deaf-blindness also means both of the following: The student has documented hearing and visual losses that, if considered individually, may not meet the requirements for visual impairment, but the combination of the losses affects educational performance. The student functions as if he/she has both hearing and visual losses, based upon responses to auditory and visual stimuli in the environment, or during vision and hearing evaluations. The determination of the disability is based upon data provided by a multidisciplinary evaluation team, which shall include assessment data from all of the following: ☐ Medical specialists such as any of the following: an ophthalmologist an optometrist an audiologist an otolaryngologist an otologist a family physician or any other approved physician as defined in 1978 PA
